## Your Automated TTRPG Note-Taker and Campaign Assistant

Archivist captures your sessions and turns them into **connected notes and campaign insights**, with summaries, timelines, highlights, and compendium updates that **reveal how your story grows over time**.

Archivist operates at the **campaign level**, linking multiple sessions, keeping entity details up to date, and powering a **dedicated campaign chatbot** that recalls facts, answers questions, and draws on your Journals for richer context. Designed for **TTRPGs**, supporting **35+ languages**, and **all game systems**.

## CAPTURE & ORGANIZE

- **Recaps:** Generates clear narrative summaries of each session and the campaign as a whole
- **Compendium & Quests:** Tracks characters, items, locations, factions, and campaign objectives as your story evolves
- **Campaign Timeline:** Displays your story's progression through a structured outline with three levels of granularity
- **Ask Archivist:** Your chatbot for fact recall, lore questions, and world-building using your campaign's history as context
- **Customization:** Adjust tone, format, and style across Archivist's outputs to match your preference

## EXPLORATION & INSIGHT

- **Moments:** Captures standout events per session, highlighting emotional turns, critical decisions, and defining quotes
- **WikiLinks & Data Studio:** Links Compendium entries for quick navigation and visualizes campaign connections
- **Cast Analysis:** Provides insight into player engagement using talk share, sentiment, and more.
- **Journals:** Permissioned prep, lore, and private or shared entries with Ask Archivist visibility controls
- **Character Arc:** Tracks your character's progression across the campaign, showing growth and relationships

## SHARING & SHOWCASING

- **Session Handouts:** Generates a shareable two-page PDF with your recap, outline, moments, encounters, Compendium, character spotlights, items, valuable information, party status, and next steps
- **Campaign Sharing:** Invite your group or publish a read-only showcase for the community
- **Digital Trading Cards:** Create shareable cards for characters, items, locations, and factions
- **Integrations:** Discord, Foundry VTT, Obsidian, plus API & MCP support for custom tools, automations, and agent workflows

## WHO IT'S FOR

### Game Masters

Track your campaign's history and events. With minimal setup, generate recaps and two-page player handouts, and use Journals, the Compendium, Timeline, and Ask Archivist for smooth prep and world management.

### Players

Players can view their character pages, track Character Arcs, collect Digital Trading Cards, revisit moments, and Ask Archivist for fact recall or inspiration for future roleplay and story ideas.

### PRIVACY & DATA

- Audio is never stored after transcription.
- No third-party data sharing.
- No model training on your campaign data.
- Your data stays yours.



## HOW IT WORKS

### 1. Create Your Campaign

**Basic Info:** title, description, system, language;

**Cast:** players and characters; and **Customize Tone** (optional) and format for Archivist's output

### 2. Log a Session

Provide your **session data** (e.g., Audio Upload), set the **date**, confirm your cast, and go!

### 3. Session Review

Once analysis completes, **review the session**

Summary, Timeline, Compendium, and Moments; edit and regenerate as needed, and finalize results.

### 4. Engage with Your World

Between sessions, use **Ask Archivist** for planning and world-building. Browse the **Compendium**, re-view **Quests**, or view your Story Arc in **Data Studio**.

## WAYS TO LOG A SESSION

### Discord (Live Voice Capture)

Invite the **Archivist bot** to your server to record live sessions. *Ignores other bots (music OK)*. Pause and resume as needed. *Bonus: includes real-time Q&A in Discord.*

### Audio Upload

Upload a **single mixed file** or **multi-track** files per speaker. **Vocal fingerprints**, cast voice profiles, and speaker discovery improve attribution before transcription.

### Text Upload (Raw Notes or Transcript)

Upload existing **notes or transcripts** to capture older sessions or fill campaign gaps.

### Play-by-Post Import via Discord

Paste the start and end message **URLs** to import a full thread as a session.

## FAQ

### How do I ensure the most accurate results and avoid bottlenecks?

- Maximize transcription quality with clear audio, minimal overlapping speech, and limited background noise.
- Improve name accuracy by assigning real players and characters in your cast list.
- Standardize spelling with Find & Replace Rules that apply automatically going forward.
- Refine summaries, descriptions, or Compendium entries directly in-app.

### How does Archivist handle hallucinations and out of game chatter?

- Archivist removes out-of-game discussion to keep outputs focused on in-game content, and its analysis stays grounded in what actually occurred in play, minimizing hallucinations.
- Stick to in-game events when prompting the AI to prevent fabricated results.
- Minor issues such as incorrect attributions or spelling can be corrected in app.
- The full raw transcript is always preserved for reference.

### How long does the analysis take?

- Usually about ten minutes after a session ends, depending on session length and complexity.

### Can multiple GMs share a Discord server?

- Yes. Multiple Archivist accounts can link to the same server, but each user must have admin access. Only one live session can record at a time.

### How is data structured in Archivist?

- Campaigns serve as containers for all related data including sessions, summaries, timelines, Compendium entries, quest objectives, and moments. Players can be invited to join and explore their campaign.
